### **4.101 REPORT CARDS AND CONFERENCES**

The School Board expects that the progress of students be communicated to parents on a regular basis by report cards and conferences. The Board believes that because students respond positively to the opportunity to succeed therefore, school personnel will seek to make achievement both recognizable and possible for students.

### **4.102 STANDARDIZED TESTS**

Each year a standardized achievement test will be given to students in grades three through twelve if appropriate. Individual test results will be sent home to the parents along with an explanation of the purpose and the significance of the test. Scores are stored on the server and tracked by the administration.

If the Director determines that sufficient reasons exist to delay or skip the administration of the test he may do so after informing the board.

The Director should review the standardized testing program on a regular basis and, in conjunction with the faculty, make appropriate adjustments that are in the best interests of the students and the school. The board should be advised of any changes.
