

## **5.60 STUDENT DUE PROCESS RIGHTS IN THE CASE OF EXPULSIONS**

The steps below shall be followed in the case of expulsion:

- A written notice of the expulsion and the reasons therefore shall be given to the parents or guardians of the student expelled. This notice shall be provided within sufficient time (minimum of three days in advance) to give the student a chance to prepare a defense.
- The student and parents or guardians of the student expelled shall be provided with a copy of the board's policy in regards to student expulsion.
- The student will be provided with the names of individuals who have primary knowledge of the facts forming the basis for the expulsion. This will permit the student and parents to discuss the facts with the authorities involved and will enable the student to present the case in a more meaningful way.
- Students shall be permitted to examine documents related to the matter.
- Students shall be permitted to obtain legal counsel.
- The student and/or student's counsel shall be permitted to cross-examine those who have primary knowledge of the facts.
