

1.20 SCHOOL LEGAL STATUS

The Tashkent International School is an independent, not-for-profit school, which is recognized by the government of Uzbekistan as part of Tashkent International Health and Education Service a non-governmental organization. The approval and governance of the school policy will be vested in the Board of Directors.

1.21 TASHKENT INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL ASSOCIATION

Members of the international diplomatic and business community created the Tashkent International School. Its operations are supported by the Association of Parents who give governing power to an 11 member School Board, of whom 8 are elected, one is appointed by the US Ambassador and up to two more who may be appointed by the Board themselves.

This Board endows the School Director with powers to perform daily operations to ensure that the School provides a high quality education. The School is an independent and not for profit organization with a mandate to provide quality education of international standards with English as the language of instruction. The curriculum will be reviewed and updated by the educational staff. Students may be of any nationality. Attached are the Articles of Association and the By-Laws governing the School Board and its employees.
