

### **1.30 SCHOOL STRUCTURE AND ORGANIZATION**

#### **1.31 THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

All legislative matters that pertain to the making of policy for the School will rest with the School Board, hereinafter called the Board. Information on the composition and duties of the Board may be found in section 2.0 of the policy manual.

#### **1.32 THE SCHOOL DIRECTOR**

The School Director, hereinafter called the Director, is the chief administrative and supervisory officer of the school. The Director is directly responsible to the Board for the execution of board policies and serves as a non-voting member of the Board. Additional information about the duties, responsibilities, and evaluation of the Director may be found in the personnel and board sections of the policy manual.

#### **1.33 THE STAFF**

The Director is responsible for the employment and, when necessary the dismissal of all personnel at the school in accordance with board policy. Personnel consist of school administrators, faculty, and support staff. Information relating to their employment may be found in the personnel section of the policy manual.

#### **1.34 THE STUDENTS**

It is the policy of the Board that no person will be denied admission to the school because of nationality, race, or creed. Student applicants will be accepted for admission unless there is reason to believe that admission is not in the best interest of the applicant or the school. Information relating to the students may be found in the section of the policy manual entitled "The Students."

#### **1.35 THE PARENTS**

The Board encourages the active cooperation and participation of the parents in the school. In order to facilitate the participation of the parents, the Board established the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA). All parents/guardians, and faculty members are automatically members of the PTA. The purposes, objectives, and by-laws of the PTA have been approved by the Board and may be found in the appendix of the Board policy manual.
