About Tashkent International School

Tashkent International School (TIS), established in 1994, is a pre-kindergarten through grade twelve international English Language school serving international and local students from over 26 different countries. It is accredited by both the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (www.neasc.org) and the Council of International Schools (www.cois.org). This means the courses, curriculum and programmes of Tashkent International School are recognized in Europe, North America and in much of the rest of the world.

In 2006, TIS launched the International Baccalaureate Diploma and Primary Years Programmes (www.ibo.org). The International Baccalaureate Organization (headquarters in Geneva) is world recognized as being the leading international curriculum in the world. The IB Diploma is accepted by 150 nations (including the European Union, the United States and Canada) as a university entrance examination. TIS is the only school in Uzbekistan to be authorized to offer the International Baccalaureate Programme.

TIS recruits licensed, experienced international educators from all over the world. TIS faculty is recruited from the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, New Zealand, South Africa, Australia, India, Latvia, Russia, Mexico and Uzbekistan. Approximately 70% of the subject teachers are international with 30% locally recruited.

Tashkent International School has an approximate enrolment of 380 students representing countries such as Uzbekistan, Korea, Germany, India, Israel, Pakistan, the UAE, and many others. TIS graduates are presently attending Brown University, Pomona College, Columbia University, University of Pennsylvania, and many other universities in North America and Europe.

The scholarship programme and committee was established in 1999 and has continued to select excellent students from the community in Uzbekistan since its inception. This year, **TIS will offer two 100% tuition-free merit and needs-based scholarships and up to six partial 50% tuition-free merit and needs-based to Uzbek nationals from local schools in grades 10, 11 and 12.** The award of this scholarship is based on academic excellence, financial need, satisfactory ability in written and spoken English, attitude and personality, extracurricular activities and interests, and potential mutual benefit to the school and to the student.

TIS offers its students:

- The opportunity to earn an International Baccalaureate Diploma
- Possible acceptance to prestigious North American and European Universities
- An excellent technological infrastructure
- Well-equipped science labs
- A modern, spacious campus
- All subjects taught in English
- Participation in international basketball and football tournaments
- Local and international teaching staff
- Classes with no more than twenty students
- Exposure to a diverse international community

Terms, conditions and procedures

Full-tuition scholarships are available for students who

- will complete the equivalent of Grade 9 or 10 by June 2011
- would be financially unable to attend TIS if the 100% scholarship were not available
- earn 4's and 5's in their local schools
- are proficient in English and possess strong reading, writing and analysis skills
- are prepared to study at TIS until graduation and will graduate before the age of twenty
- successfully complete the screening and interview process

3. *Skills test at TIS for short-listed candidates only*
Allow three hours for the ACT test to be completed on a computer.

Allow approximately 30 minutes for this interview with Scholarship Committee members.
16-18 May 2011

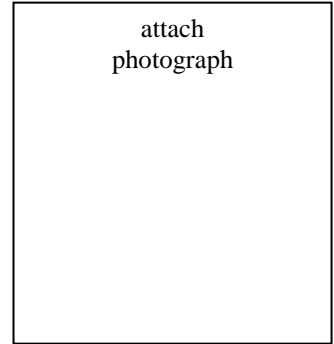
