1. Completed application form
2. One recent photograph (3 cm x 4 cm) attached to the form
3. One copy of your passport or birth certificate
4. Copy of current academic record / transcript (*only for short listed candidates*)

*\*Please do not send any documents which are not listed above.*

*Please send all documents in one email.*

**Please note:** The TIS scholarship is intended for a student whose family cannot pay the school fees, without the scholarship. For this reason, TIS will not accept regular admission applications from students who have unsuccessfully applied for the scholarship programme in the same year. This means, if a student applies for a scholarship and is not selected, that student cannot apply to TIS as a regular, fee-paying student for the same academic year.

## About Tashkent International School

Tashkent International School (TIS), established in 1994, is a preschool through grade 12 international school serving international and local students from more than 40 countries. TIS is accredited by both the New England Association of Schools and Colleges ([www.neasc.org](http://www.neasc.org)) and the Council of International Schools ([www.cois.org](http://www.cois.org)). The courses, curriculum and programs at Tashkent International School are recognized in Europe, North America and much of the rest of the world.

In 2006, TIS launched the International Baccalaureate Diploma and Primary Years programmes ([www.ibo.org](http://www.ibo.org)). Today TIS offers all three IB programmes, including the Middle Years Programme. The International Baccalaureate Organization, headquartered in Geneva, is recognized as the world's leading international curriculum. The IB Diploma is accepted in 150 countries including the European Union, the United States and Canada as a university entrance examination. TIS is the only school in Uzbekistan authorized to offer all three IB programmes.

TIS recruits licensed, experienced international educators from all over the world, including the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, India, Russia, the Netherlands, and Uzbekistan. Approximately 75 percent of the subject teachers are international with 25 percent locally recruited.

Tashkent International School has an approximate enrollment of 500 students representing countries such as the US, Korea, Uzbekistan, Germany, India, China, Israel, Pakistan, and many others. TIS scholarship students are presently attending Brandeis College, Wellesley College, Grinnell College, North Western University of Qatar and many other universities in North America and Europe.

The scholarship program was established in 1999 and has continued to select excellent students from the community in Uzbekistan since its inception. This year, TIS will offer **up to three 100 percent tuition-free scholarships** to Uzbek nationals from local schools **for admission to Grade 10 in August 2022** only. The award of this scholarship is based on academic excellence, financial need, satisfactory ability in written and spoken English, attitude and personality, extracurricular activities and interests, and potential mutual benefit to the school and to the student.

TIS offers its students:

- The opportunity to earn an International Baccalaureate Diploma;
- Possible acceptance to prestigious international universities;
- An excellent technological infrastructure;
- Well-equipped science labs;
- A modern, spacious campus;
- All subjects taught in English (except foreign language courses);
- Participation in international athletics and activities tournaments;
- International and local teaching staff;
- Classes with no more than 22 students; and
- Exposure to a diverse international community.

(Please note that Tashkent International School is not an English-training school but uses English throughout the curriculum in all classes except foreign languages)

## Application Terms, Conditions and Procedures

*Full-tuition scholarships are available for students who:*

- are citizens of Uzbekistan, and have been living in Uzbekistan for the past 9 years
- were born between **June 1, 2005 and August 31, 2007**
- are attending an Uzbek government funded school or college;
- will complete the equivalent of grade 9 or the first year of college by June 2022;
- would be financially unable to attend TIS if the scholarship was not available;
- earn excellent grades in their subjects at school;
- are proficient in Mathematics and English, and possess strong reading, writing and analytical skills;
- are prepared to study at TIS until graduation; and
- successfully complete the testing and interview processes.

### Application Procedure and Timeline

Completed application form submitted to the TIS main office.</b></p> <p>Application packages, including forms, photos, and passport copy must be submitted to the office or emailed to <a href="mailto:admissions@tashschool.org">admissions@tashschool.org</a>. If submitted in person, packages must be submitted to the Registrar (Izabella Ter-Aganova) between 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday. A completed application is required to ensure a seat at the March 25, 2022 testing session.</p>	<p><b>Before Wednesday, March 16, 2022, 4:00 pm</b></p>
<p><b>2. First round of testing at TIS. Open to all eligible applicants.</b></p> <p>Plan to participate in a variety of tests, including verbal, non-verbal, mathematical and spatial reasoning at TIS. Allow approximately 4.5 hours for this. Applicants will be assigned to a testing session once they have submitted their application.</p>	<p><b>Friday, March 25, 2022</b></p>
<p><b>3. Second round of testing at TIS for short-listed candidates only.</b></p> <p>A variety of academic tests that will take approximately 2.5 hours.</p>	<p><b>Wednesday, 30 March, 2022</b></p>
<p><b>4. Third round of testing at TIS for shortlisted candidate only</b></p> <p>A range of activities and tasks that will take approximately 2 hours</p>	<p><b>Date to be confirmed in early April after 2nd round testing</b></p>
<p><b>4. Personal interview for short-listed candidates only.</b></p> <p>Allow approximately 1 hour for an interview with members of the TIS Scholarship Committee. Short-listed candidates will be contacted about the time of this interview.</p>	<p><b>April, 2022 - TBC after 3rd round</b> (by appointment)</p>
