

Literacy Coordinator/ELL or Learning Support

Summary

The Literacy Coordinator will oversee the development and implementation of the literacy program at Tashkent International School. This position will require collaboration with teachers, staff, and leadership to foster a high standard of literacy across the school. It will be 50% Literacy coordinator and 50% ELL (English Language Learning) or Learning Support.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Lead the Elementary School's review of MAP literacy results, formative, and summative assessment data through structured data discussions to inform instructional decisions.
- Collaborate with the Primary Years Programme Coordinator (PYPC)/Assistant Principal to develop and
 maintain an assessment schedule that supports tracking and instructional planning across the elementary
 school.
- Oversee the integration of AERO standards into literacy planning documents and ensure their application in teaching practice.
- Plan, organize, and implement the PYP Professional Development program in partnership with the Principal and PYPC/Assistant Principal (AP).
- Support the development, alignment, and documentation of grade-level appropriate writing units for all elementary grades.
- Work with the PYPC/AP to create and maintain a comprehensive Scope & Sequence for writing units across the elementary school, ensuring a coherent development of writing skills and text structures.
- Attend and actively contribute to fortnightly planning meetings for Elementary classes, offering support to teachers in literacy integration, assessment, and evaluation, while incorporating Universal Design for Learning (UDL) strategies.
- Develop and lead a structured parent education program to engage families in supporting literacy development at home and to promote the academic rigour of the program.
- Coordinate the selection, acquisition, and effective utilization of appropriate reading and literacy materials to support teaching and learning.
- Stay abreast of current research and emerging trends in literacy education, integrating this knowledge into the school's practices and instructional strategies.
- Work collaboratively with parents and the wider community to promote literacy development and encourage participation in school-based literacy initiatives.
- Provide targeted support to students experiencing literacy challenges, including the organization and implementation of intervention strategies.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the literacy program through data analysis and feedback, recommending improvements where necessary.
- Serve as a resource for teachers, offering guidance and support on instructional strategies, classroom management, and assessment practices to enhance literacy teaching.
- Participate in curriculum articulation meetings with the Secondary School Subject Area Coordinator to ensure alignment between elementary and secondary literacy programs.
- Actively contribute as a member of the Elementary School Leadership Team, participating in strategic decision-making and school-wide initiatives.

Minimum Qualification

- A university degree in Education or the field taught (preferably a Master's degree)
- A minimum of five years teaching experience.
- Written and spoken fluency in English
- Experience in the IB and other professional arenas.

Tenure

Positions are assigned with a preferred two-year tenure although there is flexibility. Provided there are no concerns about performance, the incumbent is welcome to reapply for the position with no preferential condition; there is no maximum number of consecutive terms.
